Rules for Volunteering

(Adopted from the Volunteer Handbook issued by R.L. Stevenson Administration)

- All registered volunteers must be approved by the Brevard County District and School Security Division prior to volunteering. The initial application process requires fingerprints and is valid for one year. After that, volunteer renewals can be done online (fingerprints remain in the database).
- All volunteer work **must be coordinated and approved** prior to just "showing up" at the front office to volunteer.

Campus Guidelines for School Access / SIGN-IN PROCEDURES

- Sign in through the front office and be allowed entrance. Bring ID
- Serve as a positive role model. Volunteers are held to the same professional standards as the Stevenson Staff. Volunteers must be respectful, and refrain from objectionable or inflammatory topics while on campus.
- Comply with school dress code, dress conservatively.

Literacy in the Arts Night

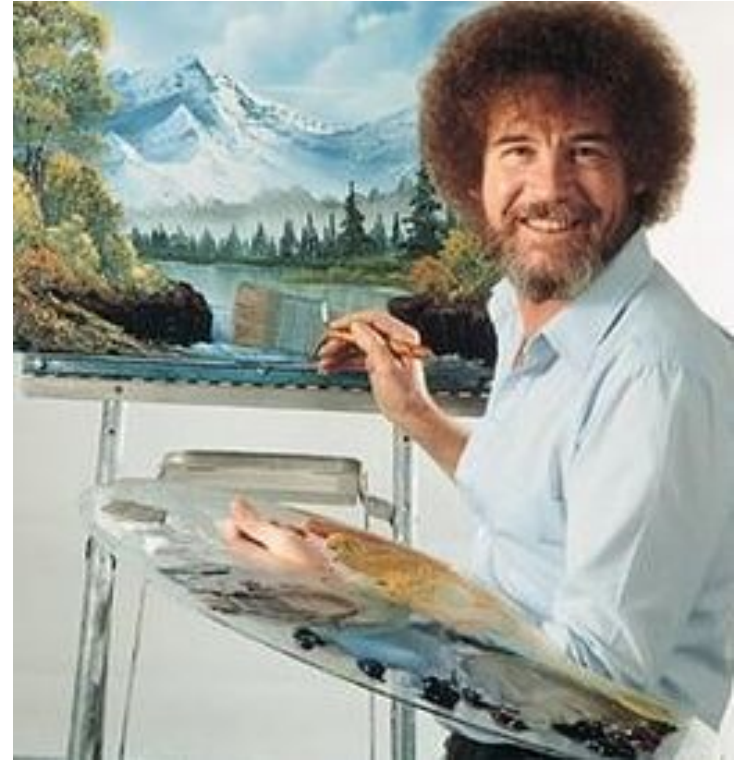
Date: January 25, 2024
